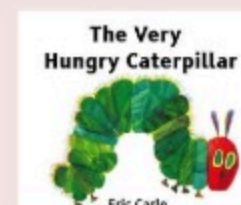
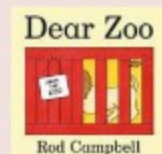
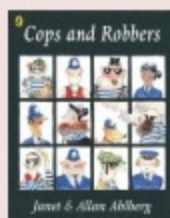
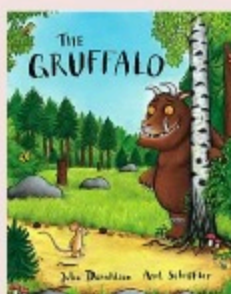
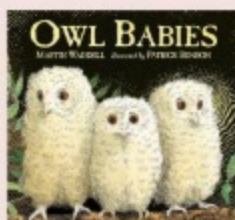
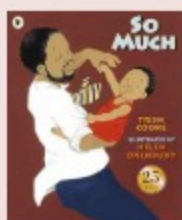


## Core Texts at William Tyndale Primary School
