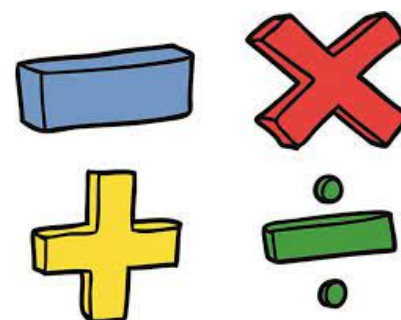
Peggy and Bea will be discussing good practice for those supporting children read in school.
